

**SPECIAL TOWN COUNCIL
MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 18, 2019**

The Town Council met in special session on Monday, November 18, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. at 372 Town Place, Fairview, Texas. Those present were Mayor Henry Lessner; Mayor Pro Tem Ricardo Doi; Councilmembers Charlie Henkle, Cynthia Brugge, Tony Mattei, Ken Logsdon and Roland Feldman. 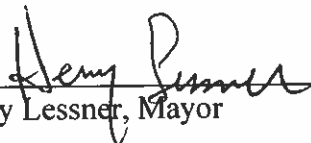

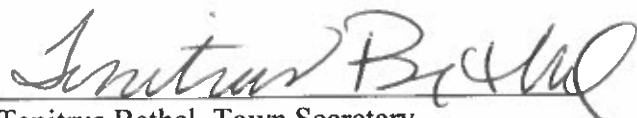
DISCUSSION ON DRAINAGE: Ms. Couch introduced the discussion of Town drainage including planning, design and operations, and related items. She reviewed the topics that would be covered and provided some history on actions taken by the Town related to drainage matters.

Mr. Chancellor then gave a presentation and discussed drainage regulations, infrastructure, planning, system operation, the engineering process, development and regional issues.
