

**FAIRVIEW TECHNOLOGY ADVISORY COMMITTEE
MEETING MINUTES
FEBRUARY 9, 2026**

1. Call to Order

Committee member Khan called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

2. Citizen's Comments

Committee member Khan called for Citizen's Comments.

Committee member Khan closed Citizen's Comments.

3. Action/Discussion Items

- a.** Approve the minutes of the November 17, 2025, regular meeting of the Technology Advisory Committee.

Committee member Khan called for the item.

The committee discussed the current draft of the next quarterly article for the Fairview Town News publication relating to passwords and enhancing digital security, which is part two of a two article series. The committee unanimously agreed that the article is ready for publication, pending minor revisions needing to

be made by town staff in order to reduce the article word count in order to better align with publication guidelines.

Staff member Wilbourn initiated discussion with the committee about the timing of its quarterly articles. Wilbourn stated that moving the quarterly article back one month would greatly assist town staff in dealing with space constraints associated with the Fairview Town News publication. The new months of publication for quarterly articles would be February, May, August, and November. The committee unanimously agreed that the proposed change to the months of publication for quarterly articles is fine.

Committee member Stanley mentioned that security of home devices connected to the internet that are utilized by households might be a good topic for a future quarterly article.

- d. Discuss internet service providers and broadband technology and services within the Town of Fairview and take any necessary action.

Committee member Khan called for the item.

The committee asked staff member Wilbourn if he knew the status of the telecom monopole that was supposed to be constructed northeast of Heritage Ranch. Staff member Wilbourn stated that he would make an inquiry to relevant town staff and provide an update at the next meeting.

Committee member Khan called for the item.

The committee agreed that a March meeting would not be held. All committee members stated that they are available for the regular meeting on April 13, 2026.

Committee member Khan called for Committee and Staff Comments.



Committee member Khan adjourned the meeting at 7:51 p.m.


