

**FAIRVIEW TECHNOLOGY ADVISORY COMMITTEE  
MEETING MINUTES  
MAY 11, 2026**

Committee Present: Committee members Chadd Jones, Tom Lester, Dick Price, and John Sunny.

**1. Call to Order**

Committee member Jones called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

**2. Citizen's Comments**

Committee member Jones called for Citizen's Comments.

Clay Medley, 710 Oakdale Circle, spoke and provided a handout to committee members regarding Flock cameras and inquired about previous committee discussion on the topic.

Staff member Wilbourn stated that the topic of Flock cameras had been talked about during a previous committee meeting and that the committee decided not to move forward with any further discussion on the topic.

Committee member Jones closed Citizen's Comments.

**3. Action/Discussion Items**

Committee member Price stated that the Friends of Fairview First Responders would be having an Open House at fire station 1 this weekend.


Committee member Lester stated that the rescheduled community cleanup event would take place this weekend.

These minutes were approved by the Technology Advisory Committee on June 8, 2026.


