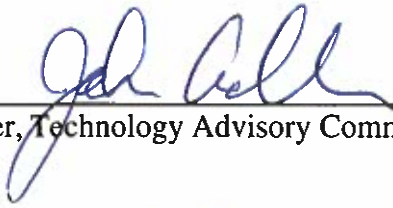
The committee discussed the fiber-to-the-home study carried out by the City of Lucas relating to internet services within their city.

5. Receive reports from staff or the Technology Advisory Committee about items of community interest.

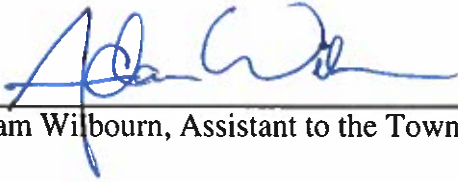
