Mr. Foster updated the committee regarding services currently being offered to Fairview residents and businesses. Mr. Foster stated that looking forward AT&T would be focused on fixed wireless access for its customers. He specifically discussed 5G technology and its deployment in other North Texas cities.

Discussion took place between Mr. Foster and the committee relating to existing services and ensuring that service deficiencies and demands are getting addressed since there is no clear launch date in Fairview for any of AT&T's new technology.

Several residents from the Quest subdivision asked Mr. Foster to please have AT&T investigate whether they could provide better internet service to their subdivision. Residents from Quest subdivision discussed the challenges they've had with internet services currently being offered by AT&T to their homes. MR. Foster stated that he would look into the issues that were brought to his attention.
