Conduct a public hearing and take action regarding a Special Use Permit for Mothers Day Out Program located within the Mosaic Christian Fellowship Church, which is located east of and adjacent to Highway 5, north of Lakeridge Drive, south of Plumwood Way, and west of Meandering Way, within the CPDD, Zone N.
 6. Conduct a public hearing and take action regarding a Special Use Permit for Splitsville, a bowling alley, located within the Commercial Planned Development District (CPDD), in Zone K.
